The next VGS South wine from Paso Robles, and oh my...does this wine OVER-deliver!

We fell in love with Paso Robles many years ago (late 90's), and it was the region's Syrah that grabbed our attention. Some of you will remember our first vineyard there called Gravity Hills and our wine called Killer Climb Syrah—so delicious!

This is its modern version—a phenomenal wine that shows a lot of black and blue fruits...black currants, blackberries and fresh blueberry notes backed up by vanilla and well-integrated, toasty oak aromas. Full-bodied and amazingly precise. On the palate, the VGS South Syrah is really balanced, elegant and rich with an amazingly long finish.

This beauty should continue to drink fantastically for another 10 years.
